Securities class action litigation has historically been a US phenomenon, but with many jurisdictions introducing suitable legislation to support strong corporate governance it is rapidly spreading across Europe, Australia and Asia. In the face of ever-increasing regulation and the continuing global financial crisis, the number of class actions is on the rise.

- Over 25% of claims that could be filed by entitled parties are left unprocessed and unrecovered*
- Between 2000 and 2007 more than US \$12 billion was unclaimed by its intended recipients through not participating in class actions*
- To date, Goal has recovered over US \$280 million in compensation for its clients

These class action events determine the rights of a group of shareholders (the 'class') who have suffered an economic loss arising from a violation of the securities laws. Whatever the reason for the class action, a shareholder may be entitled to a share of any compensation agreed or awarded. For a variety of reasons, global institutional investors today do not always claim in cases in which they may be entitled to recovery. If investors do not claim, they could be leaving a significant amount of money on the table, which will be distributed pro-rata to those entities that do claim

■ Analysis and proof of concept

To ascertain whether a portfolio is eligible to participate in any current cases, trading activity can be analysed using an automated scanning and calculation engine. This functionality enables transactions to be compared against the plethora of cases and plans of allocation to establish eligibility and the potential value of any compensation claim.

■ Online reporting

An online reporting capability is accessed via a secure website and provides comprehensive reports on all activities including:

- Alerts for new and updated cases
- Statements showing current and historic activity
- Case settlement diary detailing impending proof of claim deadlines and size of the settlement fund
- Status reports on any queries raised

■ Case settlement diary

The case settlement diary provides an overview of all impending cases, including details such as the ISIN/CUSIP codes of a company, the class period, proof of claim deadline and estimated settlement fund. See example below.

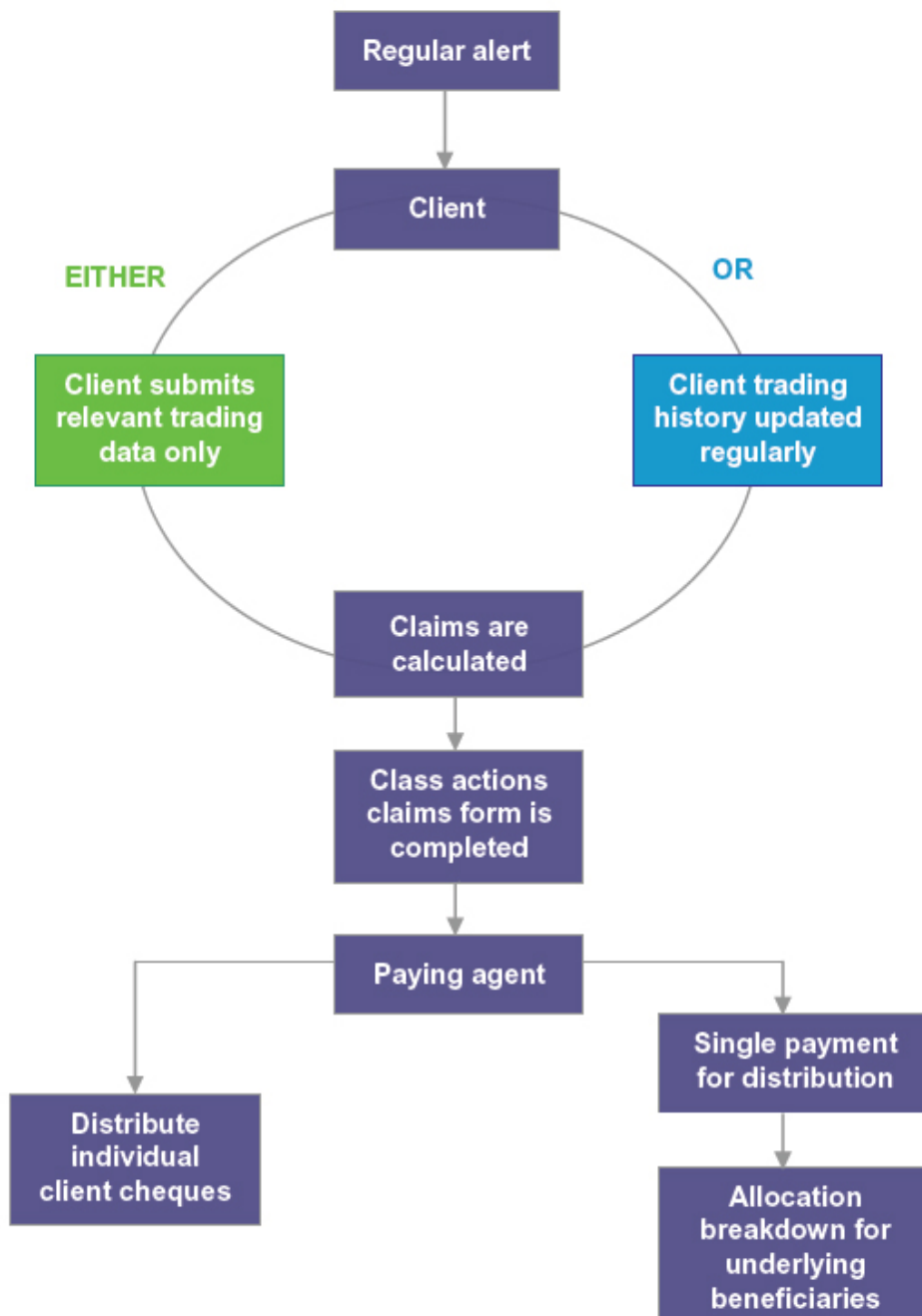
